**Project Compassion**

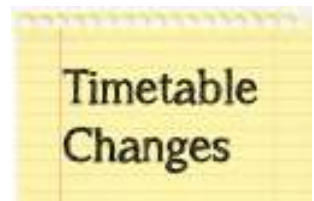
