**SAC Meeting**

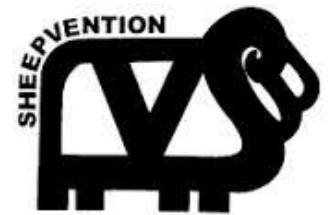
We will hold our next School Advisory Council on Wednesday the 31st of July at 7pm in the staffroom.
